The topic of the seminar is: Is Public Capital Productive? New Evidence from American States

Abstract

In this paper, we re-examine the productivity of U.S. public capital on private output. We provide updated and improved estimates of state-level public capital data for 1960 to 2020. We then include public capital and its component parts into a production function. Using conventional, spatial and dynamic hetereogenous panel approaches, we find that public capital has a positive effect on private production. Further testing however reveals that the productive component of public capital has shifted from infrastructure in 1970-85 to health and education in 2000-2020.
