The topic of the seminar is: *History, globalization, and time-varying bilateral trade cost terms in gravity*

Abstract

The presentation discusses the bilateral trade cost (terms) in gravity equations. Estimated bilateral trade cost terms are typically time-invariant in empirical gravity regressions. We consider trade cost terms that change over time. This yields two results: (1) We identify contemporary against total trade cost, enabling us to conclude on historical trade cost, i.e., trade cost as historical legacy. (2) We offer a natural illustration to globalization - international trade cost are less persistent than domestic trade cost.
